

FROM BUSINESS TO GALA BALLS


KRYSHA BALLROOM AND TERRACE

IT WAS TSAR NICHOLAS II HIMSELF WHO, IN 1908, PRESIDED OVER PLANS TO CREATE WHAT IS NOW THE CELEBRATED KRYSHA BALLROOM AND TERRACE ATOP THE HOTEL.

With its stunning stained-glass ceiling and sparkling chandeliers it quickly became the most fashionable venue in the city. Today, this period chamber has lost none of its lustre, and continues to dazzle both with its elegance and the sense of occasion it creates.

Countless historic events have been reflected in its beautiful mirrors, including the famous Six Presidents' dinner in 2006. The ballroom itself has an adjoining foyer and terrace, where a bar can be set up to welcome guests.

While these light-flooded rooms high above the streets of St Petersburg are perfect for weddings, large conferences and banquets, the ballroom can also be fully darkened for audiovisual presentations.

DOSTOEVSKY AND PUSHKIN ROOMS



GORKY ROOM

Magnificent windows allow natural light to flood into the Gorky Room, the perfect place to host business meetings and receptions. This distinguished venue, with period touches including a decorative fireplace, takes its name from the meeting held at Belmond Grand Hotel Europe in 1931 between Maxim Gorky and George Bernard Shaw.

TCHAIKOVSKY ROOM

The largest space in the Conference Centre, this can serve as the main conference room with beautiful views over picturesque Arts Square and the St Petersburg Philharmonic Hall. The room features historic elements of decor, while its name recalls the day in 1877 when the great composer visited the hotel with his young wife.








A RICH AND DISTINGUISHED RETREAT

BILLIARD ROOM

AN INTIMATE SETTING FOR A BUSINESS DINNER, MEETING OR PARTY

The wood-panelled Billiard Room on the hotel's Historic Floor features exquisite art nouveau touches such as stained-glass windows and an antique clock to create a rich and relaxing ambience. These period details are backed up by discreetly-integrated technology added during a recent renovation, including sockets for computer equipment and a screen for audiovisual presentations. The result is a venue that is distinctive, practical and redolent with character.

Well-known personalities who have attended events in this room include Vladimir Putin, Gerhard Schroeder and Jacques Chirac, who held tripartite negotiations here. Other luminaries include Juan Antonio Samaranch, King Harald V of Norway, Mikhail Gorbachev and Willem-Alexander, Prince of Orange.

A CENTURY OF CHARM


LIDVAL AND MUSEUM ROOM

AN ART NOUVEAU GEM, IDEAL FOR COCKTAILS

The lovingly-restored Lidval Room is among the most elegant of the hotel's original art nouveau venues. Its air of graceful charm makes it the perfect setting for private cocktails and intimate receptions. It is named after architect Fyodor Lidval, who helped to redesign the hotel's interiors between 1908 and 1914.

The decor features a fine Lichtenthal grand piano, inlaid with flowers and birds. Its delightful balcony overlooks the Philharmonic Hall and in summer is decked with plants.

Adjacent is the turn-of-the-century Museum Room. Ideal for private meetings or dinners, its oval table seats up to ten privileged guests.




L'EUROPE BALLROOM

Other, more decorous chapters in its life and times include receptions for Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II, Bill Clinton and the Oscar-winning film director Nikita Mikhalkov. And, on one notable occasion, Elton John was inspired to give a spontaneous concert here.


KRYSHA BALLROOM AND TERRACE


CAVIAR BAR AND RESTAURANT

The Caviar Bar & Restaurant is an exceptional venue in which to savour delectable, authentic Russian cuisine.

Its magnificent, late 19th-century interior, formerly known as the Marble Hall, transports guests back in time to Imperial Russia with a luxurious combination of crystal decorations and elegant copper furnishings. The picture is completed by the historic marble floor, columns and walls, along with the room's antique mirrors and fountain. The fine details of the interior — the tops of the columns, gilded cornices depicting crayfish and daisies and stucco wall panelling portraying centaurs — are quintessential elements of the neoclassical style that was the last word in elegance at the turn of the 20th century.




Belmond Grand Hotel Europe's name is behind some of the most noteworthy events in the St Petersburg social calendar.
