RACE TRACK - ASCARI

Ascari is located in the heart of Andalusia, near Ronda - Malaga. The longest track in Spain and one of the most spectacular in the world. Mountains and indigenous woodland characterise a terrain intentionally devoid of advertising boards common to other race circuits.

The full circuit is 5,425m long, with a consistent width of 12,2m and semi-draining surface. It can be subdivided into 3 different sections or combinations, enabling separate events or aspects of driver training to be run simultaneously.

The 26 corners of this anti-clockwise circuit are divided into 13 right-hand and 13 left-hand turns, offering a balanced course. To further challenge both car and driver, the track includes bends with up to 18% banking, 12% ascents and descents and demanding chicanes. www.ascari.net




DRIVE ROUTE: Serranía de Ronda and Pueblos Blancos

Discover the beauty of the Pueblos Blancos while enjoying the calmness of the mountainous landscape, immerse yourself in the traditional Andalusia.

1. When you leave the hotel and start heading to Serranía de Ronda area, going up the mountains you will enjoy amazing views all the way to Gibraltar and Morocco, and finally arriving at the picturesque village of Ronda

Discover Ronda, a place bursting with history as the birthplace of bull fighting - don't forget to pay a visit to the bull ring - and home to the stunning Puente Nuevo. Visit the selected winerys, have a passionate trip through the world of wine, diving into the authentic Spanish lifestyle with a copa de vino and treat yourself to some Tapas!

- 2. Drive through Algatocín, and admire the beauty of the traditional Andalusian pueblos, with steep and narrow streets, eighteenth-century houses with and there rises the church, imposing itself as the hallmark of Algatocín.
- 3. Genalguacíl is located in the heart of Valle Genal, with Moorish influences and a balcony to a mountainous landscape. Stroll along the village and be surprised with the many sculptures and paintings made by different artists during the Art Encounters, regularly hosted in the pueblo.
- 4. Time for a quick stop at Gaucín. Located on the valley at Sierra del Hacho, built by the Romans and later occupied by the Arabs, presents a varied landscape with houses, cork oaks, pine and olive trees.
- 5. Last pueblo blanco before heading back to the hotel: Casares. A historical-artistic site of Arab origin. The main attractions are the quaint streets, the Caste that stands on a limestone massif overlooking the region's valleys, and a beautiful natural environment.
