Lotte Hotel St. Petersburg

Introduction



The new five-star Lotte Hotel St. Petersburg is located in an old mansion near the Mariinsky Palace on St. Isaac's Square. The house has a rich history. It was first mentioned in historical records in 1802. For several years of its history it had served as the private residence of the first U.S. Ambassador to the Russian Empire, John Quincy Adams, who was later to become the sixth President of the USA. In the mid-19th century, the honourable citizen of Petersburg Madam Yakunchikova purchased the mansion. On September, 15th 2017 Lotte Hotels & Resorts opened the brand new luxury hotel. Lotte Hotel St. Petersburg is the first Lotte Hotel ever to be housed in a historic building. It features 150 rooms, decorated in classic and contemporary styles, The Lounge, an elegant restaurant with a stained-glass dome; MEGUmi, the first premium class Japanese restaurant in St. Petersburg; L Terrasa, a terrace bar with a spectacular view of St. Isaac's Square; and a Balinese spa salon called Mandara Spa. Four-metre high ceilings create the perfect space for a relaxing holiday, while cinematic views of St. Isaac's Square, Mariinsky Palace and Moika embankment provide an invaluable gift for all the guests of the new first-class hotel.



Interiors and accommodation



The 150 hotel rooms have been designed in great detail by NHDC studio. The interiors feature several types of marble and natural wood, luxury Italian furniture, exclusive textiles, 100% wool English carpets and 11 different types of pillows filled with goose down, sheep wool, lavender and mint blend, etc. It offers two stylistic concepts: the "classic" rooms on the second and third floors of the hotel, and the contemporary design rooms on the fourth and fifth floors. The 7 suites, including a spacious presidential suite with an area of 216 m², provide the special feature of the hotel. Careful attention is paid to personal care products: there are Molton Brown beauty product sets to be found in all rooms along with special BVLGARI sets for the suites. A magnificent stained glass chandelier and a five-meter painting of the Church of the Savior on Blood were especially created for the hotel lobby.


