

At the heart of the Corinthia brand lies the Corinthia Palace Hotel & Spa in Malta. Originally a 19th Century artdeco villa, Alfred Pisani and his family opened the Corinthia Palace in 1962 as a fine-dining restaurant, later transformed into one of Malta's first luxury hotels.

The Corinthia Palace Hotel & Spa was built by a modest team of workers, which included the Pisani brothers themselves, who were responsible for laying the hotel foundations brick-by-brick with their own bare hands. Fuelled by a vision of crafted hospitality, the Spirit of Corinthia was born.



MALTA: THE WORLD'S OLDEST MEETING PLACE





Gozo, meaning 'joy' in Castilian, is often referred to as the Mediterranean's best kept secret.




COMINO – THE BLUE LAGOON
